The Company controls and manages risk to achieve continual improvement of our environmental performance and to prevent pollution.

- Maintaining an environmental management system which conforms to ISO 14001:2015
- Manufacturing and assembling our full range of products on-site, where possible, helping to significantly reduce our carbon footprint.
- Taking environmental issues into consideration when making core business decisions, including investment, innovation and operational or working practises
- Managing and monitoring its significant environmental aspects
- Compliance with all applicable environmental legislation and with other requirements to which the organisation subscribes which relate to its environmental aspects. This will be achieved by maintaining a register of legislation as part of our environmental management system as well as completing regular compliance audits

- Demonstrating continual improvement in environmental performance by setting quantifiable objectives and targets. Progress towards these targets will be reported and reviewed at annual management review meetings

The following are our strategic goals:

- To minimise waste going to landfill and monitor and minimise energy, paper, and water consumption, by increasing staff awareness
- To ensure the risk of fire is minimised thereby reducing the risk of air and water pollution arising from fire on premises
- To minimise usage of chemicals which are harmful to the environment and ensure their safe disposal
- Prevention of pollution at our site and from our activities by regularly checking our control procedures for waste disposal are being followed
- To minimise pollution arising from use of private vehicles and reduce unnecessary mileage.
